Dress Code

On the Course

- Neat, casual dress should be worn.
- Players are encouraged to wear sports shirts with collars, dress shorts, smart trousers/slacks. No singlets
- Players must wear golf shoes with soft spikes (no metal spikes). Suitable sports shoes e.g. cross trainers are acceptable in summer conditions. No thongs
- Players are encouraged to be Sunsmart and to wear suitable, practical clothing

In the Clubhouse

- Neat, casual dress should be worn.
- Hats and caps to be removed in the clubhouse

Visitors

- Members are responsible for ensuring that guests are aware of the CGC dress expectations.

Club Uniform

- When representing the Club at external events, for example Pennant competitions,
 - all players should wear up to date Club shirts
 - players should ensure that their uniform is in good condition.
